ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose of application for bail moved by applicant Satnam Singh alias Mani named above in case FIR mentioned above.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State and the learned Addl. PP for the State appeared and contested the same. Police record

was summoned and produced.

3. I have heard the learned Counsel for the applicant-accused, learned Addl. PP for the State and have carefully gone through the record.

4. Learned Counsel for applicant-accused has argued that applicant-accused is innocent and has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. The alleged recovery falls within non commercial quantity. Applicant-accused is in custody since 11.02.2019. The conclusion of trial will take time. He argued that applicant-accused undertakes to abide by all the terms and conditions to be imposed by the Court while releasing him on bail and prayed that applicant-accused be released on bail.

5. On the other hand, learned Addl. PP for the State has opposed the bail application and contended that allegations against the applicant-accused are serious in nature. Accused is the member of gangster group, which used to smuggle arms and ammunition. She argued that applicant-accused is not entitled for concession of bail and prayed that bail application be dismissed.

6. After considering the rival contentions of learned Counsel for the applicant-accused, learned Addl. PP for the State and going through the record, this Court is of the considered view that bail application deserves dismissal.

7. Perusal of the record reveals that FIR No. 01 of 12.02.2018, under Sections 15, 18, 21, 25 & 29 of NDPS Act & 25 of Arms Act was registered at Police Station SSOC, Amritsar, on the allegations that Inspector Gurinderpal Singh, during the intervening night of 11/12.02.2019, while acting upon secret information, apprehended Daljit Singh alias Babla and Satnam Singh alias Mani alias Garja alongwith an I-20 Car bearing no. PB02-CS-8767 and two pistols .32 bore, nine cartridges, 50 grams heroin and drug money of Rs. 2,08,000/- (Indian currency) were recovered from their possession. During investigation, the names of Guddu, Raghu and Rakesh Kumar surfaced being connived with the co-accused in the commission of offence. On 15.02.2019, accused Rakesh Kumar alias Raghu was arrested and one pistol .32 bore with magazine and four cartridges of same bore were recovered from his possession and during investigation, it was revealed that all abovesaid accused have formed a group, who used to smuggle arms & ammunition. The investigation has not yet been completed. So, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, applicant-accused is found not entitled to the concession of bail. As such, bail application is dismissed. Bail application file be attached with concerned remand papers.
