Sharanbir Singh versus State of Punjab

Heard. The FIR in this case has been registered on the basis of the statement made by complainant Gurpreet Singh. As per his version, on 15.05.2022, at about 8:00/8:30 p.m., he was present at his house. Two boys came in front of his house on a motorcycle and they had knocked at the gate of his house. They had challenged the complainant to come out of the house and that they will teach him a lesson for making false complaints against him. When the complainant had partially opened the gate of his house, he saw that the Mangu was on the driving seat of the motorcycle and the applicant/accused Sharanbir Singh was on the pillion seat of the motorcycle. The applicant/accused was carrying a pistol in his right hand. The applicant/accused allegedly fired two shots towards the complainant with the intent to kill him. However, both the shots had crossed over the gate of the house of the complainant. When the complainant raised *raula*, the said persons ran away.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has argued that the applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the instant case due to previous enmity between the parties. He has argued that on 15.05.2022, the applicant/accused had gone on his truck to Dalhousie and he had stayed in a hotel at Dalhousie. The Investigating Agency can verify this

fact from the record of the said hotel and he will provide the necessary details to the Investigating Officer. He further submits that even the bills issued by the hotel will be produced.

3. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor submits that the allegations against the applicant/accused are very serious and even the weapon of offence is yet to be recovered.

4. It is a case of no injury. The Investigating Officer has informed the Court that he did not find any mark of fire arm on any part of the house of complainant as the complainant has alleged that the said shots had crossed above the gate of his house. Keeping in view the entire facts and circumstances, the applicant/accused is directed to join the investigation by causing his appearance before the Investigating Officer within three days and in the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer shall release him on interim bail on his furnishing of bail bonds to his satisfaction. The bail application is adjourned to 01.06.2022. It is further ordered that the applicant/accused should furnish the details of the hotel, wherein he allegedly stayed at the relevant time. By the next date, the Investigating Officer should verify this version of the applicant/accused.
