ORDER:

1 The present application for regular bail has been moved on behalf of accused-applicant Baljit Kaur for offences under Sections 22 and 29 of NDPS Act by virtue of Section 438 Cr.P.C.

2 Notice of bail application has been given to the State. Police record has been requisitioned. Record has been perused and arguments have been heard.

3 As per allegations on 10.04.2023 ASI Gurmail Singh along with other police officials HC Ajaib Singh, HC Gurjant Singh, L/SC Mamta Rani, PHG Hardeep Dass, on official vehicle no.PB-13AW-4113 along with laptop, printer, etc., in connection with patrolling and checking

of suspected persons and vehicles, were going from Baguana to Ubhawal road and when the police party was short of half kilometer from Ubhawal road, then one lady was seeing coming from the right side carrying transparent plastic envelope and that lady on seeing the police tried to flee from spot after throwing the aforesaid transparent envelope. However, she was apprehended and she disclosed her name as Baljit Kaur wife of Nehru Singh resident of Ram Nagar Basti Sangrur. On checking of that transparent envelope thrown by that lady, 500 intoxicant tablets of white colour were recovered, which were taken into police possession. Case was got registered against that lady.

During interrogation, that lady disclosed that her brother Lakhwinder Singh had been supplied those intoxicant tablets to her. On that offence under Section 29 of NDPS Act was added and Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakha son of Mohinder Singh resident of Indra Basti Sangrur was nominated as accused in this case.

4 It may be submitted at the very outset that as per case of prosecution, 500 loose intoxicant tablets of white colour were recovered from the envelope so thrown by applicant-accused Baljit Kaur. The report of FSL has not been received and therefore it cannot be ascertained at this stage as to whether such recovery comes within the preview of non-commercial quantity or commercial quantity but at the same time such recovery is quite heavy. Therefore, in the given set of circumstances, applicant-accused Baljit Kaur is certainly not entitled to the concession of

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regular bail. Accordingly, her bail application is dismissed. Police record be returned. File of bail application be attached with the other connected papers of this case.
