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First Bail application Under Section 438 Cr.PC.

ORDER:

1. By this order, this Court intends to deal with the present bail application under Section 438 Cr.PC having been filed by applicants Mal Singh and Kailash Rani.

2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and perused.

3. I have heard the respective contentions of both the learned Advocates and have perused the record with their able assistance.

4. The applicants are mother-in-law and father-in-law of complainant who are stated to have harassed the complainant on the demand of dowry including the demand of a car. The complaint in question was moved by the complainant against as many as 9 family members & relatives of her in-laws but FIR in question was registered only against the present applicants and their son only. The bail has been opposed on the ground of recovery of gold ornaments given to the applicants at the time of marriage as such, for that purpose the

applicants may be given an opportunity to join the investigation. Moreover, perusal of the file reveals that a notice under section 41-A Cr.PC has been served upon the applicants by the police with intention to join them in investigation. Keeping in view such circumstances, it is appropriate to direct the applicants to join investigation before the next date of hearing in this bail application. Hence the applicants are directed to join investigation accordingly and in the event their arrest, the I.O./S.H.O. Police Station Sadar, Jalalabad is directed to release the applicants on bail on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount each to his satisfaction and subject to the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.PC.

5. Bail application stands adjourned to 24.08.2021 for report of compliance and arguments for final disposal of this bail application.
