

**IN THE COURT OF RAJINDER SINGH, PCS, JUDICIAL
MAGISTRATE FIRST CLASS, BATALA**

1. Arguments heard on bail application. Ld. counsel for applicant/accused has argued that applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. There is no direct or indirect evidence to connect the applicant/accused with the present case. The alleged recovery is 4 Grams including the wrapper and wrapper also contains the weight and it is well settled that the weight of recovered Heroin falls under the small quantity. The applicant is in judicial custody for a long time and he is no longer required for further investigation. It is further argued that no such or similar application for bail under any provision has been filed before Hon'ble High Court or any Appellate Court.

2. On the other hand, Learned APP for the State has orally opposed the contentions raised by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and argued that the applicant/accused has committed serious offence in nature. He has further prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

3. Considered. The applicant/accused is in custody since his arrest i.e 26.02.2025. Further, as per allegations of prosecution, the recovery of 4 Gram Heroin (alongwith polythene bag) has already been effected from applicant/accused. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind the bars. Keeping in view the custody of applicant/accused and the nature of offence, the bail application is allowed and applicant/accused **Gurbhej Singh @ Shee son of Jagdish Singh, resident of village Dheer, Police Station Sadar Batala** is admitted on bail, subject to furnishing of bail bonds in sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount with an undertaking not to tamper with the evidence of the prosecution and to appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing and not to leave the country without prior permission of the Court. Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. The present file be attached with the connected file.
