Accused/applicant has moved the present bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for accused has argued that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He has also argued that nothing is to be recovered from the applicant and he is ready to join the investigation. Learned counsel for accused has further argued that the only allegation leveled against the applicant has been that he raised Lalkara.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground of seriousness of the offence.

Record has been received and perused. As per the contents of the FIR on 24.12.2019 at about 08:00 am Amrik Singh complainant and

his son Harpinder Singh were present in their house. Gurpreet Singh armed with rode, Ladhu alias Lovepreet Singh armed with Dattar, Sukha Singh armed with baseball, Kuldeep Singh, Pash son of Pappa Singh, Ajay Singh empty handed trespassed into the house of the complainant and abused them. Pash raised Lalkra. Ajay Singh caught hold Amrik Singh. Kuldeep Singh caught hold Amrik Singh from his right arm. Gurpreet Singh gave rode blow hitting on his left arm. Labbu alias Lovepreet Singh gave dattar blow hitting on his left arm. Sukha Singh gave basebal blow hitting on his left arm. Above said persons also gave beatings to his son Harpinder Singh.

Only allegation against applicant has been that he raised Lalkara. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant. In such circumstances the court is of the view that it would be in the fitness of things and larger interest of justice and investigation that the that accused is directed to join the investigation till 14.02.2020 and in such event the applicant/accused shall be admitted on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer/investigation officer/SHO concerned of the police station subject to conditions:-

- a) The applicant shall join the investigation and corporate with the same as and when called by the investigation officer.
- b) He will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- c) He will not leave the country without prior permission of the court. Report be submitted in this court and for consideration on the said

date.
