ORDER

1. Record of the investigation received.
2. Heard.
3. The present case was registered on the statement of Manjit Singh son of Gurmukh Singh as his four buffaloes and one bull were stolen from the cattle shed of the complainant on the intervening night of 3-4.7.2023. Accused Gufran son of Islam resident of village Baghra Ner Sherpur, Police Station Tatavi District Muzaffar Nagar (U.P), during interrogation in FIR No.256 dated 13.11.2022 under sections 457, 380 of IPC and Section 11 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animal Act, 1990, Police Station Sadar Samana, admitted that he alongwith Bhuru alias Mursleen son of Furqan, Shahbad alias Shahdab son of Sahnu, Asif son of Qayuum,

resident of Baghra near police station Sherpur, Tatavi, District Muzaffar Nagar (U.P), have committed the theft of four buffaloes and one bull in the intervening night of 3-4.7.2023. Thereafter, the accused-applicant was nominated as accused in that case. He was arrested in the present case on 06.11.2023.

4. The accused is in judicial custody. The presentation of report under section 173(2) of Cr.P.C and trial of the case will take a long time. Though, six other FIRs were registered against the accused-applicant, but the law will take its own course. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused-applicant in custody. Therefore, bail application moved by the accused-applicant is allowed and the accused-applicant be released on bail on fulfilling the following conditions:-

1. Accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.10,000/-.
2. He will also produce the surety of the like amount.
3. He will give an undertaking in the learned Trial court that he will not indulge in other criminal activity.
4. If, in the breach of the undertaking given by accused-applicant, the prosecution could move an application for the cancellation of the bail.
5. The learned Trial court/Duty Magistrate will be competent to cancel the bail of accused-applicant, in the event of his absence.
