Particulars :-

1. Prayer :- Regular bail.
2. Offence :- C.R.No. 72/2026
Section 64(2)(m), 69, 351(2) of BNS
3. Police Station :- Dahanu.
4. **Grounds in bail application :-**
 - a. Applicant is innocent.
 - b. False implication.
 - c. Alleged offences not made out.
 - d. No criminal antecedent.
 - e. He is bread earner of his family.
 - g. Permanent address and no possibility of absconding.
 - h. Accused ready to abide by bail conditions.
5. **Say of Prosecution :- (Exh.05)**

- a. Accused has committed sexual intercourse by making promise to marry with victim
- b. Victim is pregnant.
- c. Accused may influence the investigation.
- d. Accused may repeat the crime.
- e. Accused may threaten witnesses.
- f. Accused may abscond.

6. **Say of Victim :- (Exh. 06)**

Accused has promised to marry with her. She has no objection to release the accused on bail. She filed complaint under pressure of her relatives against accused.

7. **Argument :-**

Heard rival sides.

8. **Decision :-**

Nothing has remained to be seized from the applicant. Applicant is arrested on 30/04/2026. Conclusion of trial may take time. Applicant is young. There is no criminal antecedent. There has been a consensual sexual intercourse between victim and accused. This is a case of romantic relationship in the adolescent age, which has also resulted in sexual intercourse due to opposite sex attraction. The victim has no objection to release the accused on bail. There does not appears the probability of tampering with

evidence. Conditional bail order would suffice. So, I pass following order.

ORDER

- 1 Application is allowed.
2. Accused shall be released on furnishing PR bond of Rs.30,000/- with one or two sureties in the like amount.
3. Accused shall not threaten witnesses.
4. Accused shall co-operate in trial.
5. Accused shall submit updated contact number and residential address.
- 6 Bench Clerk to inform this order to the concerned.
- 7 Prosecution can seek cancellation of bail if any condition is violated by accused.
