State Of Punjab VS Lovejeet Singh etc.

An application for amendment in the head note of the bail application has been filed by counsel for the accused on the ground that Section 437 Cr.PC mentioned instead of 480 B.N.S.S. Heard. In view of the averments mentioned in the application, same is allowed. Amended head note filed.

Heard on the bail application moved on behalf of accused Lovejeet Singh. It is averred in the bail application that accused is innocent and falsely implicated in the present case. Investigation of the case has been completed and the accused is not required for the purpose of investigation and nothing is required to be recovered from the accused. It has been further submitted that the presentation of challan & conclusion of trial will take long time. Hence, he prayed for concession of bail.

On the other hand, Ld. APP for the state strongly opposed the bail application filed by accused/applicant and requested for dismissal of the same.

Record perused. Accused was arrested in this case on 16.06.2024. Presentation of challan will take a long time. Alleged recovery of 4 Grams Intoxicant Powder (Heroine) is small quantity and has already been effected from accused. The Court is of the considered opinion that keeping the accused further in custody would not serve any purpose rather it would burden the state exchequer. Therefore, keeping in view the principle that jail is an exception and bail is a rule, accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to following conditions.

1. That such person shall attend in accordance with the conditions of the bond executed under the chapter.

2. That such person shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected.
3. That such person shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
4. That the accused shall inform the court in case of change of his address immediately without any delay.
5. That accused shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the court.
6. That in case the accused is having a passport, then he must supply the copies of the same and in case he is not having passport, then he must submit an affidavit qua the said fact.

Requisite bonds not furnished. Papers be attached with the remand papers.
