ORDER

Record received. Arguments heard.

2. It is mentioned in the application that accused/applicants are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further averred that alleged recovery has already been effected and applicants have been wrongly implicated in this case. It is further averred that no case is made out against accused/applicants from the bare perusal of FIR and allegations leveled against them by prosecution are altogether false and frivolous. It is further averred that accused/applicants were arrested on 30.8.2020 and thereafter they sent to judicial custody. It is further averred

that accused/applicants undertake to appear on each and every date of hearing, as such, they may be granted regular bail.

3. Learned counsel for the accused/applicants while arguing in the lines of the application contended that application may be allowed and accused may be granted bail.

4. Conversely, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State submitted that accused/applicants have committed serious offence and as such they do not deserve the benefit of bail and application may kindly be dismissed.

5. Having heard the arguments, it has transpired that the instant case FIR was registered when on 30.8.2020 accused/applicants were apprehended and from them 385 kilograms poppy husk was recovered in the truck bearing no. PB-05AB-2808. Thus, keeping in view the serious allegations against accused/applicants, they do not deserve the concession of bail. Resultantly, bail application is ordered to be dismissed. Record be returned and bail application papers be tagged with the main file.
