ORDER

1. Bail application put up before me being Duty Judge in view of order dated 30.3.2020 bearing No.2/SPL/RG/Misc. of Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and order of learned District & Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, bearing endorsement No.8618-8623/P2C dated 11/06/2020.

2. Today, ASI Amarjit Singh No.2328 BTL of Police Station Sekhwan, appeared and suffered statement that petitioner Veer Kaur has joined investigation on 08/06/2020 and her custodial interrogation is not required for further investigation.

3. Heard. The petitioner was admitted to interim bail by this court vide order dated 06/06/2020. The injury qua which the offence under section 326 IPC is added in the FIR, is not attributed to the petitioner. Only simple injuries have been attributed to her. She has already joined investigation. The allegations against the petitioner are matter of evidence, which shall be led during the trial of this FIR. Keeping in view above facts and circumstances as well as the statement suffered by ASI Amarjit Singh, the present bail application is hereby

allowed and order dated 06/06/2020, vide which petitioner was admitted to interim bail, is hereby made absolute. Copy of this order be sent to the court of learned Illaqa Magistrate for attaching the same with the remand papers/FIR. Police record be returned. Record of present bail application be consigned to the record room.
