By filing a verified petition Under Order 6 Rule 17 r.w. Section 151 of CPC, Ld. Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that due to inadvertence and typographical mistake, the registration number of the vehicle mentioned in the column 15 of page 2 of the original claim petition has been written as WB-62Q/0357 in stead of WB-60Q/0357, that is required to be corrected for proper adjudication of this case. The petition is duly supported by an affidavit.

The copy of the petition has been served upon the Ld. Advocate of the OP/Insurance Company and endorsement has been made to that effect.

Seen the materials on record including the documents filed in support.

Considering the fact that the proposed amendments are formal in nature and the same if allowed, will not change and character of the proceeding, I am inclined to allow the same.

Accordingly, the present petition Under Order 6 Rule 17 of CPC, is allowed.

The claimant is permitted to amend the original claim application in terms of this petition and file amended copy of the same after serving it upon the other side.
