ORDER

1. This order disposes off bail application of accused described in detail herein above.
2. It is alleged on behalf of accused that accused innocent and not committed any offence and in custody since 23.10.2017.

3. The application was contested by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State on the ground that the quantity recovered from the accused falls in the commercial quantity and the bail cannot be granted to the applicant.

4. Appreciating the contentions aforesaid and having carefully gone through the police record, it is found that the accused Nursi Ram is alleged to had in possession :

(800 Tablets of Lomotil, average weight 63.81 mg) (800 x 63.81 = 51.04 gm) (DIPHNOXYLATE) .

The quantity recovered from the applicant/accused falls in the category of commercial quantity. In view of Section 37 of the NDPS Act, 1985 the accused not entitled to bail, bail application is accordingly dismissed.

5. The copy of this order be placed with the remand papers and this file be consigned to the record room.
