ORDER

1. This order shall dispose of regular bail application filed by applicant Hardeep Singh in a case FIR No. 66 dated 03.06.2021, under Section 18,61,85 of the NDPS Act, P.S Dhakoli, SAS Nagar (Mohali).
2. It has been averred in the bail application that the applicant/accused was arrested on 03.06..2021 by the police and has been

illegally detained the applicant without cogent evidence. A totally false case has been planted upon the applicant by the police. The applicant/accused is innocent and is a law abiding citizen. He has not committed any offence. The FIR has been falsely registered against the applicant. It has been further averred that challan has not been presented yet and it will take long time to complete the trial. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind the bars. The applicant is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the Court, if any.

3. Brief facts of the case are that Police officials of Police Station Dhakoli were laid Naka at M.M. Enclave, Dhakoli and at around 10:00 PM, two persons came from Mubarikpur side and after seeing the police party they thrown some black material wrapped in Plastic polythene on the ground and tried to fled away from the spot, but applicant/accused Hardeep Singh and his co-accused were apprehended by the police officials and on weighment 107 grams of Opium wrapped in plastic polythene was recovered from the conscious possession of applicant/accused Hardeep Singh and the present FIR was got registered against the applicant/accused.

4. The applicant is in custody since 03.06.2021 i.e. approximately more than one month. The contraband recovered from the present applicant/accused i.e. 107 grams of Opium, which falls in the category of non-commercial quantity. No useful purpose will be served by detaining him further in custody as the challan is not likely to be presented soon. As such, no ground is made out to decline the bail

application, especially in the phase of Pandemic Covid-19. In view of the same, the applicant/accused namely Hardeep Singh is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions:-

- I) That he will appear on each and every date of hearing in the Court till the disposal of this case.*
- ii) That he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court,*
- iii) That he will not win over the witnesses of the prosecution of this case.*

Bail application stands allowed. File be consigned to the record room.
