Accused Parvej Alam is produced from JC.
A Bail prayer files on behalf of custody accused.
Ld. PP is present. A written objection against prayer for bail has been filed on behalf of prosecution.

Bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Lawyer for the accused as well as Ld. PP who raises strong objection against the prayer for bail quoting the provisions of Sec.37 of the NDPS Act.

Perused the case record.

In this case commercial quantity of contraband has been recovered from the possession of the accused. So there is no scope to hold that accused is not guilty before recording evidence. But accused prays for bail on the ground of enjoyment of ensuing Id-Ud-Joha festival. Festive season is knocking at the door so accused may be permitted to enjoy the festival. Hence prayer for bail is allowed for a limited period.

Accused may find an interim bail of Rs.5,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each for the period till next date.
