ORDER:

Arguments on bail application heard. Police record perused.

2. The accused/applicant has averred that he has been arrested by the police of P.S. Lalru on 02.04.2024. The accused has been falsely implicated by the police in the present case. Previously, the applicant/accused was arrested and released on bail on 10.08.2015. It is further submitted that previous counsel of the accused/applicant had told the applicant/accused that he shall appear on his behalf in the present case and will inform the accused/applicant as and when required, due to which, he could not appear and ultimately, declared proclaimed offender. The applicant/accused is ready to furnish the bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the court and the accused is ready to comply with the terms and conditions imposed by the court. The applicant/accused undertakes that he will appear on each and every date and will not leave India without the prior permission of the court.

3. On the other hand, Ld. APP for the state has argued that accused was already declared a proclaimed person and there is likelihood that accused may again misuse the concession of bail, if granted bail. Therefore, he prayed for dismissal of the instant bail application.

4. I have heard the Ld. APP for the State and counsel for the accused and perused the case file carefully.

5. It is matter of record that the accused/applicant was declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 01.12.2023, as even after presentation of challan, he did not appear in the court. Thereafter, accused/applicant was arrested on 02.04.2024 and since then, he is in judicial custody. The accused could not justify his absence during the relevant period. In view of the given circumstances, this Court does not find it a fit case to grant concession of bail as there is apprehension that he may again misuse the concession of bail. Therefore, considering the conduct of the accused/applicant, bail application of accused Ravi Kumar is **dismissed**. Papers be tagged with main file.
