

State Vs Raj Kumar @ Mangi

File taken up today before me being Duty Magistrate as Ld. Illaqa Magistrate has gone to avail summer vacations w.e.f. 01.06.2023 to 15.06.2023. Heard on the bail application having been filed on behalf of accused/applicants Raj Kumar @ Mangi in **FIR No. 83 dated 14.05.2023 registered against him City-I, Abohar, under section 457/380/511 of IPC & 25/54/59 Arms Act.** It has been averred in the application that no offence has been committed by the applicant/accused and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It has been further averred that accused is in custody since 14.05.2023. It has been further averred that accused undertake not to temper with the prosecution evidence and will not misuse the concession of the bail granted by the court. It has been further averred that accused/applicant will abide all the terms and conditions if any imposed by the court and will not leave India without prior permission of the court. It has been further averred that accused is law abiding citizen of India and he is ready to furnish surety bonds and bail bonds as per the satisfaction of this court. At end, a prayer has been made to release the accused on bail.

2. Upon notice, Sh. RS Jossan, Ld. APP has appeared on behalf of the State, but he did not intend to file reply to the present application and opposed the same on the grounds of gravity of offences.

3. From the perusal of the case file, it reveals that allegations against the accused is under sections 457/380/511 of IPC & 25/54/59 Arms Act. The accused/applicant is under detention since the date of his arrest i.e. 14.05.2023. The presentation of challan and completion of trial thereof, will take considerable time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in judicial custody for indefinite period. Therefore, without commenting upon the merits of the case, accused **Raj Kumar @ Mangi** is ordered to be released

on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to following conditions:-

- 1) He shall not commit similar type of offence.
- 2) He shall not induce or threaten witnesses of the case and shall not tamper with evidence of the case.
- 3) He shall come present on each and every date.

Bail bond and surety bond not furnished, Papers be attached with the remand papers. Copy of this order be send to accused through concerned Jail Superintendent. File be sent back to the concerned court immediately.
