**ORDER**

1. The Petitioner / Accused has filed the present petition for bail U/s. 480 of B.N.S.S for the offence U/s. 329(4), 85 BNS. The learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner / Accused argued that the Petitioner / Accused was innocent person he was falsely implicated in this case. It was also added that in the event of granting bail the Petitioner / Accused was ready to furnish sufficient sureties and he was also ready to comply with any conditions imposed by this court.

2. In the reply received from the respondent and prosecution it was stated that if the Petitioner / Accused was released on bail, he may get absconded and again commit the similar nature of offence and he may tamper with evidence and he may escaped from the clutches of law. It will prejudice the case. There by the investigation

will be hampered. Hence they strongly object to release the accused on bail.

3. By considering the arguments and by verifying the case records it seems that the accused was in judicial custody for past 02 days. By considering the nature of offence and facts and also the circumstances of the case this Petition is allowed on the following conditions:

1. The Petitioner / accused shall execute a bond each for a sum of Rs.10,000/- along with 2 sureties each for like sum;
2. The sureties shall affix their 3 colour Photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and also produce two photographs and copy of their Aadhar card and Family card to ensure the identity ;
3. The Petitioner / accused shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M. for the period of 30 days;
4. The Petitioner / accused shall not abscond or tamper the witnesses during the case investigation or trial and also directed to Co-operate with the case investigation.
