ORDER:

ASI Kuldeep Singh No.833/PTA posted at PS Urban Estate, Patiala has suffered a statement that applicants/accused Arpandeeep Singh Tarun Kumar, Gurpiar Singh and Nishu Chaudhary had already joined the investigation on 20.06.2021. The recovery of vehicles has been effected. Now applicants/accused are not further required for the purpose of

interrogation.

2. Heard and record perused. Perusal of police record shows that applicants/accused has joined the investigation in pursuance of interim order dated 18.05.2021. In these circumstances, the custodial interrogation of applicants are not warranted as they have already joined the investigation on 20.06.2021. The interim order dated 18.05.2021 is, therefore, made absolute subject to the compliance of provisions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the applicant shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

1. that the applicants shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Illaqa Magistrate till presentation of challan and thereafter without the permission of the trial court;
2. that the applicants shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
3. that the applicants shall continue to cooperate with the investigating agency;
4. that the applicants shall regularly attend the hearings before the trial Court;

4. In case the applicants misuses the concession of bail by absenting themselves from the proceedings, the trial-court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order. The present bail application file be consigned to the Record Room, after due compliance.
