ORDER:

1. Put up before me being Duty Officer. This order will dispose bail application u/s 439 Cr.P.C. moved by above named accused-applicant Rajan Kumar, in FIR No. 138 Dated 22.10.2017 u/s 379-B,411/34 IPC, PS Division No.6, Jalandhar.
2. Upon notice, this application was contested by ld. District Attorney for State.
3. I have heard learned counsel for the accused-applicant, ld. District Attorney for the State and have gone through the file very carefully with their able assistance.

4. Learned Counsel for the accused-applicant pleaded that the accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is alleged that accused was arrested in this case on 05.11.2018 and since then he is in Judicial lockup. No recovery has been effected from the accused. A false and concocted story has been put forward by the police officials in connivance of the complainant. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused indefinitely in the Judicial Lockup except burden on the state exchequer. Hence it is prayed that bail application may kindly be allowed.

5. On the other hand, ld.District Attorney for state pleaded that offence attributed to the accused-applicant is very serious in nature and no leniency is required in such like matters. Hence, prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

6. From the facts of the case, the allegations against the accused are under Sections 379-B/411/34 IPC. Applicant/accused is in Judicial lock up since 05.11.2018. Accused/applicant has been arrested in this case and recovery has already been effected. The criminal liability of accused under these sections is yet to be ascertained. Challan has already been filed, which is pending in the court of Shri K.K. Goyal, learned ASJ, Jalandhar. It will take sufficient time for its conclusion. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused indefinitely in the Judicial lock up except burden on the state exchequer. As such without commenting on the merits of the case in hand and keeping in view the prevailing pandemic of

Covid-19, the accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- before the Superintendent Central Jail, Kapurthala. Superintendent Central Jail Kapurthala is directed to take personal bonds of accused Rajan Kumar and to release him from jail if not required in any other case. Separate release warrants will not be issued by this court. He is further directed to send the personal bonds to this court within one month. Accused is directed to furnish the surety bonds when the Courts will start normal functioning. Copy of this order be forwarded to Central Jail, Kapurthala for information. Bail file be put up before learned Sessions Judge, Jalandhar after 18.05.2020 for entrustment purposes.
