Today is fixed for production and I.O's report.

Accused person namely Md. Alam Sekh is produced from J.C through VC and remanded to J.C.

One bail petition is filed on behalf of the accused person. Copy served.

Ld. PP-in-charge is present by filing hazira and files a separate petition praying for rejection the bail application.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person is present.

Bail petition is moved.

Heard both sides.

Perused the case record.

Ld. Advocate submitted that this accused is in custody since **24.09.2025**. He had voluntarily surrendered. Since then he is in custody. He was also taken in PC on 25.09.2025 for five days. The allegations brought against the accused is fabricated. The accused is not involved in the offence. Ld. Advocate accordingly, prayed for allowing bail to the accused on any condition.

Ld. PP submitted that the seizure shows recovery of commercial quantity of suspected brown sugar. The procedure of search and seizure has been properly performed. Ld. PP accordingly, prayed for rejection of bail petition.

After hearing of both sides and on perusal of the case record, it appears that the case involves recovery of commercial quantity of suspected brown sugar and investigation is going on. Moreover, this is no prima facie material to hold that this accused is in no way involved with the alleged offence. There is also no such material to hold that if the accused is granted bail, he shall not indulge into similar kind of offence.

In the circumstances I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail of the accused person. Hence, the bail prayer of the accused person Md. Alam Sekh stands rejected at this stage.

Accused person be remanded to J.C till **18.12.2025**.
