ORDER

Today, ASI Gurwinderpal Singh No.454/Btl, P.S. Dinanagar has appeared along with record and suffered statement to the effect that accused/applicant Sylwestor has come to police station Dinanagar on 28.05.2026 but he has not cooperated with investigation and has not disclosed the names of co-accused.

2. Accused/applicant Sylwestor suffered his statement that he had visited the police station Dinanagar as per the order of the court continuously since 28.05.2026 but IO had not allowed him to join with the investigation. He stated that he has already disclosed all the facts which are in his knowledge and fully cooperated with the investigation.

3. Heard. Accused/applicant was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 22.05.2026 with direction to join the investigation. As per the statement suffered by ASI Gurwinderpal Singh, accused/applicant Sylwestor has come to police station Dinanagar on 28.05.2026 but he has not cooperated with investigation and has not disclosed the names of co-accused. The accused/applicant on the other hand has suffered the statement that he had visited the police station Dinanagar as per the order of the court

continuously since 28.05.2026 but IO had not allowed him to join with the investigation. He had stated that he has already disclosed all the facts which are in his knowledge and fully cooperated with the investigation. Learned defence counsel had contended that the accused/applicant cannot be expected to state self incriminating facts and infact it is the duty of the investigating agency to bring the investigation to the logical ends.

4. From the statement of ASI Gurwinderpal Singh, it is evident that the accused-applicant had come to police station Dinanagar on 28.05.2026. The version of the accused is that he had been visiting Police Station since 28.05.2026. Thus from the said statement, it is evident that the accused/applicant had visited police station Dinanagar to join the investigation but it has been alleged by the investigating agency that he had not cooperated with the investigation as he did not disclose the name of co-accused. The accused from the statement suffered by him appears to be willing to join the investigation. ASI Gurwinderpal Singh is not the investigating officer of the present case. Investigating officer of the present case is stated to have gone to Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh. Let the investigating officer be called alongwith police file on 04.06.2026.
