ORDER (ORAL):-

Petitioner Sagar son of Tarsem has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 518 dated 28.12.2022, Under Sections 379-B, 201 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State and Sh. Amit Goklaney, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor appeared on behalf of

the State.

3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the the petitioner was earlier arrested and was granted the benefit of bail in this matter and was even attending the trial proceedings, which were subsequently conducted before this Court, after the case was committed for trial. She argued that during the pendency of the trial, petitioner met with an accident on 23.11.2025 and sustained serious injuries. He was hospitalized and diagnosed qua disk displacement and thus, advised strict bed rest for considerable period. Accordingly, he could not appear on 09.12.2025 due to the said reason and even could not contact his counsel to move appropriate application seeking exemption. Resultantly, his bail order was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by him were forfeited to the State and his presence was sought through coercive methods by issuance of non-bailable warrants. Learned counsel argued that the petitioner has himself surrendered on 27.04.2026, after his medical condition was somewhat stabilized, although she argued that the petitioner is still undergoing treatment. She, thus, presses for grant of regular bail.

4. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor has not disputed the aforesaid factual position, in so far as the absence of the petitioner is

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concerned. He, however, has left it on the Court to decide the fate of the petitioner by pressing that the petitioner has misused the concession of bail once granted to him.

5. I have considered the submissions made at the bar.

6. The factual position is not disputed with regard to the absence of the petitioner on 09.12.2025. The fact that the petitioner has sustained injuries and is undergoing treatment is specifically pleaded in the bail application, supported by a certificate dated 10.03.2026 issued by *Guru Nanak Mission Charitable Hospital*. There is no reason to disbelieve the same. Accordingly, the present bail application is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of this Court. Papers of bail application be attached with the file of main case.
