On notice, Ld. Addl. P.P. has appeared for respondent-State.

Main file pending for 05.02.2020 put up by the Ahlmad. Same is also perused. Heard on this application of applicant for regular bail in this case.

2. It is contended by Ld. Counsel for applicant that latter has been falsely implicated in this case. He is in custody since long. Main witnesses already have been examined by prosecution. Disposal of challan will take time. Hence, the prayer to admit applicant to regular bail.

3. Ld. Addl. PP opposed the bail application while submitting that allegations against applicant are heinous. Releasing him on bail will give him opportunity to abscond. Applicant may not influence PWs if is released on bail. Therefore, the prayer to dismiss the bail application.

4. Allegations against the applicant are that he was in illicit relationship with co-accused/non-applicant Sarabjit Kaur. This applicant was a Bus driver. On 3.12.2018 at about 10-30 P.M. both accused murdered Balwinder Singh (husband of said Sarabjit Kaur) and hanged his dead body with the hook of ceiling fan in his house in village Dalel Singh Wala. Though complainant PW has been examined but many of the

prosecution witnesses including medical witnesses are yet to be examined. Allegations against accused-applicant are quite serious in nature. Admitting him to regular bail may not give him the opportunity to abscond or to influence prosecution witnesses. Bail application of co-accused Sarabjit Kaur also was dismissed by this Court earlier. Keeping in view the totality of these circumstances, I do not find if any ground is made out to admit applicant to regular bail. His application is dismissed. It be attached with the main file which be returned to Ahlmad for date fixed.
