

State Vs. Prem Singh @ Prem Kumar.

Heard on bail application of accused. The prosecution has filed reply to the said application. Accused Prem Kumar was arrested on 03.10.2022 and he is in custody since then. The allegations against the accused Prem Singh @ Prem Kumar are that the present case was registered against Anmol Singh @ Abhi, Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakhi, Happy, Prem Kumar, Amarjit Singh on the statement of Dilbagh Singh that he is an agriculturist. The cattle room is separate from the house, where they had kept the electric motor on the hay cutting machine. On 29.09.2022 he went to his house after cutting hay on the hay cutting machine. When he came in the evening and saw that there was no electric motor on the hay cutting machine. He tried to look for his electric motor till now. He came to know today that Abhi, Happy and Lakhi Sood stole the electric motor from the locality and sell the same to Prem Kumar and Amarjit Singh in their shop situated opposite Gurudwara Chaswal. If raid is conducted on the house and shop of Prem Kumar and Amarjit Singh, the electric motors can be recovered from their possession. During the course of investigation, the police party arrested accused Anmol Singh @ Abhi on 02.10.2022. During the course of interrogation, accused Anmol Singh @ Abhi confessed that he, Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakhi and Happy have stolen the electric motors from village Chaswal on 26.09.2022 and from the cattle house Village Jatiwal of Dilbagh Singh on 29.09.2022 and they sold these electric motors on Mastana Scrap Store of Prem Kumar and Amarjit Singh. Thereafter, on 03.10.2022 the said electric motors were recovered from Mastana Scrap Store of Prem Kumar and Amarjit

Singh. Since presentation of challan and conclusion of trial is likely to take considerable time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. Rather it would be burden on state exchequer. Accordingly, accused Prem Singh @ Prem Kumar is granted bail, subject to furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Papers be tagged with the remand papers if any.
