

BA CIS No.1481 of 2019 Parmodh Kumar Vs. State of Punjab

ORDER

File put up before the undersigned being Vacation Judge.

Through this application the applicant Parmodh Kumar has sought regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 193 dated 25.5.2019 under Section 279/337/338/427 of IPC registered at Police Staton Zirakpur.

It has been averred in the bail application that the applicant could not attend the court on 14.02.2019 as he is a driver by profession and was out of station. He could not contact his counsel. Now he has been summoned through nonailable warrants of arrest.

Perusal of lower court record reveals that the case is at the stage of prosecution. The applicant absented from the Court on 14.02.2019. Before this he has been regularly appearing before the trial Court. He has filed this application immediately after cancellation of his bail order which shows his bonafide contention to join the proceedings of the case. In view of the above, the applicant is directed to surrendered before the trial Court on or before 20.07.2019 the date already fixed in the case and in the event of his arrest he should be released on bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, failing which, his bail application should deem to have been dismissed. Lower Court record be returned. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
