One bail petition is filed on behalf of the accused person. Copy served.

Perused the case record from which it reveals that the accused has been detained in police custody for 5 days on and from 04.11.2024 and produced before this Court.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused person submitted that the accused person is an innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this present case. The bar of Section 37 of NDPS Act is not applicable in this case as the investigation officer did not comply the provisions as per law.

Ld. Spl. PP strongly opposes the prayer for bail.

On careful perusal of the case record, it reveals that total 196 bottles of phensedyl cough syrup was recovered from the possession of the accused person. Considering all aspects of this case and after hearing of both sides and on careful perusal of the case record I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail of the accused person.

Hence, bail prayer stands rejected.
