

BA.1628.26 State of Punjab VS Mumtaj Kaur

Present: Sh. GS Brar, Advocate, counsel for accused/applicant.
Sh. AS Adiwal, Addl. PP for the State.

Heard on the application under Section 483 of BNSS moved on behalf of the accused/applicant, namely Mumtaj Kaur wife of Angrej Singh, resident of Village Jhatra, Tehsil Zira, District Ferozepur, for her release on bail in the case bearing FIR No.31 dated 04.03.2025, under Section 21(C), 27(B) & 29 of NDPS Act and Section 25 of Arms Act, PS Kot Ise Khan.

2. Notice of bail application was given to the State and Additional PP appeared and contested the bail application.

3. From perusal of the record it revealed that 2.5 kg Heroin along with drug money of Rs.1,00,000/- and two country made pistols .32 bore were recovered from the accused/applicant and co-accused on 04.03.2025 in the house of accused/applicant at Cheema Road, Kot Ise Khan, which falls in commercial quantity. There is bar of Section 37 of the NDPS Act in granting bail in cases involving commercial quantity. At this stage, it cannot be opined that accused/applicant is not guilty of commission of crime under NDPS Act or will not commit any such offence again. Therefore, the accused/applicant is not entitled to the concession of regular bail. Hence, the bail application stands dismissed. Bail application be attached with corresponding papers.
