ORDER:

1. Present application filed on behalf of applicant/accused Pooja Rani seeking pre arrest bail in the matter, details of which have been referred above, shall be disposed off through this order.
2. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and perused.

3. I have heard the respective contentions of both the learned Advocates and have perused the record with their able assistance.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused pointed out that applicant-accused has been nominated alongwith her husband Gagandeep Singh. The total liquor involved in this case is about 60 litre. It was also argued that the applicant-accused is pregnant and false case has been planted against her due to the grudge of the police against the husband of the applicant. Now keeping in view the fact that applicant-accused is on family way and further she is ready to join the investigation and also not involved in any previous case of like nature, no useful purpose would be served by sending her behind the bars as such, the bail application stands allowed. Hence the applicant is directed to join investigation accordingly and in the event of her arrest, the arresting officer of concerned Police Station is directed to release the applicant on bail on her furnishing bail bonds to his/her satisfaction and subject to the conditions under Section 482 BNSS. File be consigned to the record room.
