ORDER

Police record has been produced by HC Balbir Singh, P.S.

Cantt Ferozepur, which has been seen and returned. Arguments on bail application heard.

FIR was lodged by the complainant Bodh Raj son of Wazir Chand, resident of House No. 514, Housing Board Colony, Ferozepur City with the allegations that he was doing the work of Tailor. In the month of April, 2017, he had handed over the documents to the applicant for registration of his new motor cycle Discover 125 CC. The applicant demanded Rs. 5500/- for the said purpose. The complainant gave him the documents and Rs. 4500/-. After receipt of the documents and the amount, the applicant gave a receipt to the complainant, which was a forged and fabricated. He made an enquiry and came to know that the applicant had not deposited the documents with the office of Transport Department, Ferozepur. After that he neither returned the documents nor the money. A prayer was made to take action against the applicant.

The police record shows that the receipt dated 24.04.2017 regarding deposit of the documents and amount given to the complainant by the applicant was got verified from the office of DTO, Ferozepur. The said receipt was shown to be valid upto 15.05.2017. On verification by the police from the office of DTO, Ferozepur, it was reported that the receipt was not issued by their office.

From the above facts, it is found that applicant received the amount of Rs. 4500/- and documents for registration of the motor cycle.

of the complainant. He issued a receipt in this regard allegedly issued by the office of DTO, Ferozepur and on verification by the police, the said receipt was found to be forged. Keeping in view the allegations in the FIR and the investigation proceedings, applicant is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail. As such his bail application in the above referred is dismissed. Copy of this order be conveyed to the concerned police station. Record be consigned.
