ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose of an application for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of applicant Veerpal Kaur in case FIR No: Not known, Dated: Not known Under Section: Not known, Police Station: Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

2. In pursuance of notice of the application having been issued, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has put in appearance. Report of Ahlmad has been perused. As per report of Ahlmad, no application filed by the applicant is pending nor any application has been decided by the Hon'ble High Court.

3. Learned counsel for applicant has urged that the applicant apprehends that she might be falsely implicated in a criminal case by the local police, as her house is being raided continuously by the police officials of Police Station, Sardulgarh. The police officials even entered the house of the applicant by scaling over boundary wall of her neighbours, with whom the applicant is not having cordial relations. They threatened to involve the applicant in some false criminal case. The applicant is ready to abide by the directions, if any imposed. The application be allowed and the applicant be accorded blanket anticipatory bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has hotly opposed the contentions and has argued that as per official ASI Maya Ram from Police Station, Sardulgarh, till date neither any FIR has been lodged against the applicant qua a non-bailable offence,

nor any application or complaint is pending against her. The applicant cannot be accorded blanket anticipatory bail. The application be dismissed.

5. After giving my thoughtful consideration to the rival submissions and on careful perusal of the averments put up in the application, perusal of statement recorded of ASI Maya Ram from Police Station, Sardulgarh, coupled with the assistance rendered, it is apt to make mention that till date neither any FIR has been lodged against the applicant qua a non-bailable offence, nor any application or complaint is pending against her. Hence, the Court does not find any substance in the submissions put forth by learned counsel for the applicant. The applicant cannot be accorded blanket anticipatory bail. Hence, the application being devoid of merit is hereby dismissed. But, before parting with the present order, it is made clear that in case any FIR is lodged qua a non-bailable offence on the basis of averments put in the application, then 5 days prior notice shall be served upon the applicant. Copy of order be sent to the SHO of concerned Police Station for compliance. Police record be returned. File be consigned to the record room.
