ORDER :

This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application filed by applicants-accused under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.149 dated 25.05.2020, under Sections 188 of the IPC and Section 353, 186, 506 of the IPC (added lateron) registered at P. S. City Sunam, District Sangrur.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and police record has also been requisitioned.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicants-accused and Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record very carefully.

4. It has been contended by learned counsel for the applicants-accused that the applicants-accused have not committed any offence. They have been falsely implicated in the present case FIR. No any police officer lodged any complaint in P. S. city Sunam regarding violation of curfew/lockdown on 21.05.2020. the alleged information is alleged to be o 21.05.2020, whereas the present FIR has been lodged on 25.05.2020. Therefore, there is inordinate delay in lodging the FIR. The applicant-accused is ready to join the investigation and co-operate with the same. A prayer has been made to admit the applicant-accused to anticipatory bail.

5. Ld. Public Prosecutor for the State on the other hand, has opposed the bail application by submitting that as per the allegations made in the FIR, on 21.05.2020 at about 10:30 P.M. during the lockdown imposed in the State of Punjab, the applicants-accused alongwith their co-accused person were violating the curfew/lockdown in the presence of police officials and a video showing this illegal act of the applicants-accused was also went viral. The applicants-accused used to wander here and there at Chohata Bazar, Sunam intentionally and proclaiming that nobody can stop them from doing so as now there is no curfew imposed in the State and thereby they violated the order of the District Magistrate, Sangrur. So, for thorough investigation of this case,

the custodial interrogation of the applicant-accused shall be required. As such, a prayer has been made to dismiss the anticipatory bail application filed by the applicant-accused.

6. From the perusal of the file, it transpires that the present case FIR has been registered against the applicants-accused and co-accused person on the basis of aforesaid allegations that the applicants-accused alongwith their co-accused persons violated the curfew/lockdown in the presence of police officials and a video showing this illegal act of the applicants-accused also went viral. The applicants-accused used to wander here and there at Chohata Bazar, Sunam intentionally and proclaiming that nobody can stop them from doing so as now there is no curfew imposed in the State and thereby they violated the order of the District Magistrate, Sangrur. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant-accused in this case. Keeping in view the totality of the facts and circumstances of this case, the applicants-accused are directed to join the investigation on or before 11.06.2020 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be admitted to interim anticipatory bail by the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer/SHO concerned. Compliance report be called for 11.06.2020.
