ORDER.

1. This is an anticipatory bail moved by applicant/accused Amit Kumar in FIR 09 dated 23.01.2018, under Sections 498-A/406 IPC registered at Police Station Behrampur.
2. On 02.07.2018, interim relief was granted to accused/applicants by passing following order:-

“ Bail application received by way of transfer. It be registered.

2. Present bail application has been filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C on behalf of accused/applicant Amit Kumar for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 09 dated 23.01.2018, under

Section 498-A/406 IPC, P.S.
Behrampur.

3. Notice of the bail application was given to the State. Sh. K.S. Gill learned Additional P.P. has put in appearance on behalf of the State.

4. Record has been produced.

5. Arguments heard.

6. Contention of Sh. R.K. Kashyap learned counsel for applicant/accused is that applicant/accused and complainant namely Sunaina have compromised and they are residing together. Even a petition for quashing the FIR in question has been moved by the parties before Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court. He also put the attention of this court towards the compromise dated 02.03.2018. His contention is that custodial interrogation of accused is not required. Applicant/accused is ready to join investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Agency.

7. Adjourned to 09.07.2018

8. In the meantime applicant/accused is directed to join investigation and cooperate with the IO. In the event of arrest of applicant/accused, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of IO/Arresting Officer, subject to

conditions laid down Under Section
438(2) Cr.P.C”

3. Today ASI Kanwaljit Singh No. 956/GSP came present alongwith record to record his statement to the effect that applicant/accused has joined investigation and his further custody is not required in the present case.
4. Accordingly, this court considers that no useful purpose would be served by taking the applicant in custody.
5. Present application for anticipatory application succeeds and same is hereby allowed and order dated 02.07.2018, whereby interim bail was granted is hereby made absolute.
6. Police record be returned and file be consigned to record room.
