Ld. Regular P.O is on duty for Special Intensive Revision.

This is an application under section 483 of B.N.S.S. praying for bail filed by the accused as against the rejection order of the Ld. Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate Islampur in connection with **Goalpokher P.S. case no.10/2026**, dated 06.01.2026, U/S- 118(1)/125/109(1)/3(5) of BNS, r/w sec 25/27/35 of Arms Act, pending before Ld. ACJM, Islampur.

Received the LCR and CD.

Now, the case record is taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Addl. P. P. and Ld. Counsel for the accused/petitioner.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that no application of a similar nature was/is preferred before the Higher forum nor a similar nature of the application was rejected.

On query, Ld Addl. P. P. submits that there is no reflection in the CD that there is any bail application either pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court and IO also did not intimate him that any bail application is pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld Advocate for the accused petitioner submitted that the accused petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He was not named in FIR. Ld. Advocate further submitted that the incident took place on 06.01.2026. FIR was made on the very date. But statement u/s. 183 of BNSS was recorded on 16.02.2026. No prayer for TI parade was made. He is in custody since 13.01.2026. So, he prays for bail of the accused petitioner.

Ld Addl. P. P. raised objection.

Heard. Considered.

Perused the materials on record and the Case Diary including injury report and seizure list. Accused petitioner is not named in FIR. I also perused the statement of one victim namely Irfan recorded u/s. 180 of BNSS on 08.01.2026 at page no. 38 of CD by putting my initial signature on the reverse side of page no.32 and statement u/s. 183 of BNSS recorded on 16.02.26 at page no.163 of CD. Accused is in custody since 13.01.2026. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of detention, I am inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, petition u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. stands **allowed**.

Hence, the petitioner, namely, **Amjad Ali** may find bail of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs.1500/- each on condition to meet the IO once in a week till filing charge sheet, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. A.C.J.M., Islampur.
