

Ravi Kumar vs State

Present: Sh. SP Sharma Adv. counsel for appellant.

Appeal received by entrustment. It be registered. There are arguable points involved in the appeal. Hence same is admitted, subject to all just exceptions.

Along with the appeal, an application has been moved for suspension of the sentence. Heard. Appellant/ accused has been convicted and sentenced for the offence u/s 411 of IPC. The appellant was on bail at the time of decision of the case by the ld. trial court. As per assistance rendered by counsel for appellant, fine, which was imposed by the trial court, and was released on Interim Bail.

As the disposal of the present appeal is likely to take time. Hence, keeping in view the facts, the sentence of imprisonment awarded to the appellant/ accused is suspended till the decision of the appeal, subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety to the satisfaction of Trial Court/ Duty Magistrate within 15 days. Let notice of the appeal be issued to State for 13.09.2017 and trial court file be also requisitioned. Trial Court shall immediately upon furnishing of bail bonds, shall furnish that record to this court at own before next date of hearing. Copies of these directions be also sent to the concerned Trial Court.
