Ld. Regular PO is on duty for Special Intensive Revision.

This is an application u/sec. 482 of the BNSS praying for anticipatory bail filed by the accused/petitioner in c/w Karandighi P.S. Case no.51/2026 dated 22.02.2026 under section 115(2)/137(2)/3(5) of the BNS r/w Section 8/12 of the POCSO Act.

Heard Ld Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld Special P P.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner gives an undertaking and submits in open court that no other application of a similar nature is either pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court or the Ld. Sessions Judge, Uttar Dinajpur.

Ld lawyer for the accused petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent. He is the father of principal accused. He is not involved in the alleged crime. He further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation. Therefore, he may be granted anticipatory bail on any condition.

Ld. Special PP produces the CD and raised objection against the bail prayer.

Perused the materials on record, Case Diary including FIR and the statements of the victim recorded u/s 183 of the BNSS. The accused petitioner is the father of principal accused.

Having heard the submissions of both sides and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as materials available in the case record and the CD, this court is of the considered view that custodial detention of the petitioner is not required for the investigation.

Hence, the petition u/s 482 of the BNSS stands **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner **Rabiul Islam @ Rabul Ali** may be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs.4000/- with two sureties of Rs.2000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer on condition to assist the investigation of the case. He is further directed to abide by the conditions as mentioned u/s.482 (2)(i)(ii)(iii) (iv) of the BNSS.

CD be returned.

The application is disposed of.
