This is an application under section 483 of B.N.S.S. praying for bail filed by the accused petitioners as against the rejection order of the Ld. Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate Islampur in connection with **Chakulia P.S. case no.51/2026**, dated 14.02.2026, U/S- 318/335/345/349 of BNS, r/w Sec. 7(I)(ii) of the Essential Commodities Act, pending before Ld. ACJM, Islampur.

Received the LCR and CD.

Now, the case record is taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Addl. P. P. and Ld. Counsel for the accused/petitioners.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners submits that no application of a similar nature was/is preferred before the Higher forum nor a similar nature of the application was rejected.

On query, Ld Addl. P. P. submits that there is no reflection in the CD that there is any bail application either pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court and IO also did not intimate him that any bail application is pending or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld Advocate for the accused petitioners submitted that the accused petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. They are in custody since 15.02.2025. So, he prays for bail of the accused petitioners.

Perused the materials on record and the Case Diary including statement recorded u/s. 180 of BNSS and seizure list. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of allegation, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused petitioners on bail.
