Today is fixed for evidence.

Out of eight accused persons, seven accused persons in custody are produced four from Sub-divisional Correctional Home, Islampur and one accused namely, Md. Gulam Mustafa @ Baba produced from Balurghat Central Correctional Home and two accused are produced from Malda Correctional Home through VC and one accused Saddam Alam @ Bhulu on court bail is present.

Ld. P.P Mukhtar Ahmed and the Ld. defence Advocates in four sets namely, Sanjay Kumar, Gurudas Saha, Firoj Ahmed and Prasunjoy Sinha are present.

The witness Safi Kamal, ASI of Police is examined as PW6 (CSW), he is cross-examined and discharged.

The accused Md. Gulam Mustafa @ Baba from Balurghat Central Correctional Home through VC alleged that he was kept in a separate Cell confined for 24 hours like convict and he is not provided his normal right of UTP. He further submitted that he wish to talk with his family members and Advocates during the custody period.

The Superintendent, Balurghat Central Correctional Home, is hereby directed to follow that the right of the above UTP not been infringed and he should get all the available facilities as provided for under trial prisoner.

**Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the Superintendent of the Balurghat Central Correctional Home, for compliance.**

A petition is filed on behalf of the accused persons for supplying the copy of the CCTV footage and FSL report with supplementary charge sheet.

The prosecution is hereby directed to supply the same after making a copy of the CCTV footage and the other documents accordingly.

**To 09.04.2025, 10.04.2025 and 11.04.2025** for further evidence as per the CS witness list, due to the ensuing 'Roza' from 01.03.2025 to 31.03.2025 and as the accused persons are all Mohammadan by caste, the date of evidence is extended beyond a month.

**Later: Order on bail petition filed by accused Debendar Paswan @ Bhajan Paswan:**

Dated: 19.02.2025

A bail petition is filed by accused Debendar Paswan @ Bhajan Paswan.

He is in custody at Islampur Sub-Divisional Correctional Home.

Copy supplied to the Ld. Prosecution who raised strong objection.

The bail petition is taken up for hearing.

It is fact that the trial of this case is already started but at very initial stage only six witnesses are examined and considering the evidence already on record it appears that a conspiracy was made to kill the victim in a cinematic way on the open road and in the daylight. The accused persons though representing separately are all habitual offenders and have several cases. The offence prima facie is an organised crime and the role of each accused individually is not ascertained at this initial stage. The geographical location of the area and considering the gravity of the offence there is a great probability of absconding of the accused which is very often occurred in this Court.

The Addl. P.P stated that the Hon'ble High Court considering the gravity of the offence rejected the bail applications repeatedly.

The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused submitted that the accused is under custody since his arrest and till date there is no such materials reflected against him.

Considering the submissions and evidence on record along with observation of the Hon'ble Court, the bail petition of accused Debendar Paswan @ Bhajan Paswan is **rejected**.
