To day is fixed for production and evidence.

Ld. P.P. files hazira and present.

The accused Md. Ali, Md. Arman Raja and Kadir Alam are produced through VC mode from the Correctional Homes at Islampur, Malda and Balurghat respectively.

Accused persons namely Bikash Chowdhury, Devender Paswan, Gulam Mustafa, Ashim Babu and Md. Tamrej are present on dock while remaining accused namely Saddam Alam on CB is absent by petition and represented by their Ld. Advocate under section 355 of BNSS.

One witness namely Abdul Wahab is present before this Court and he is examined and cross examined as PW-22 and discharged accordingly.

No other witness is present today.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the **accused Kadir Alam** files a bail petition.

The bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Hd. Ld. Advocate for the accused as well as Ld. P.P. in charge.

Perused the case record and already the evidences on record.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused person submitted that the accused is innocent and falsely implicated in this case and also submitted that he is a local resident and he has no chance of tampering with the evidence of prosecution in any manner.

Ld. Addl. P.P. raised vehement objection stating that he may again abscond if the bail granted to him.

It appears that already 22 witnesses are examined in this case. The trial is nearly to the end.

Considering the above mentioned facts, objection of the P.P. and also considering the social impact, **the bail application of the accused Kadir Alam can not be considered at this stage, hence rejected.**

The Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused Kadir Alam files a petition that his right must not be infringed during his stay in correctional home at Balurghat.

The accused is not produced physically but based on the petition by his Ld. Advocate the 'Superintendent of Balurghat Central Correctional Home' is directed to act as per law so that the constitutional rights of accused be not infringed.

Let a copy of this order be sent to 'The Superintendent, Balurghat Central Correctional Home' for his information and further necessary action.

Ld. Advocate of accused Golam Mustafa files a petition that due to his medical emergency he may permit to visit 'Ram Monohar Lohia Hospital, New Delhi, at- Baba Kharak Singh Road, near Gurudwara Bangla Sahib, Type III Connaught Place'. Considering his statement and in view of petition, he is permitted to visit above mentioned hospital on appointment and directed to deposit the entire medical file on return.

To : 06.03.2026 and 07.03.2026 for remaining CS witnesses and the prosecution is directed to issue summons accordingly.
