

POCSO Case NO.15 / 2022

Accused namely Akash Singha is produced from correctional home. He is remanded to JC till 13-06-2022.

One bail petition filed for accused Akash Singha.

One surrender bail petition along with vokatnama filed on behalf of accused persons, namely, Sanjoy Singha and Potoka Singha @ Ranjana Singha. They are taken into custody and remanded to JC till 13-06-2022.

Heard ld advocate for the accused and ld Special P P.

Ld advocate for the accused submitted that the case was initially stated u/s 363/365 IPC. Subsequently section 4 of POCSO Act has been added. The FIR has been lodged after two months of the missing of the victim girl. His client Akash Singha is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case and he may be granted bail on any condition.

As regards the surrendering accused persons ld advocate for the accused submitted that they have been granted bail by this court and they are appearing before the court for getting regular bail.

Ld addl P P submitted that CD is not with him but bail application of accused Akash Singha was earlier rejected by this court after perusing the statement of the VG u/s 164 Cr.P.C. He opposes the bail prayer of accused Akash Singha. But he has nothing to say about other two accused persons who have been granted anticipatory bail by this court.

This is a case u/s 4 of POCSO Act and in her statement u/s 164 Cr P C the victim girl brought serious allegation against accused Akash Singha, and, considering all aspects this court is not inclined to grant bail to the accused Akash Singha.

Hence, bail prayer for accused Akash Singha considered and rejected at this stage.

From the record it appears that in CrI misc case no. 338/2022 this court granted anticipatory bail to the surrendering accused persons, namely, Sanjoy Singha and Potoka Singha @ Ranjana Singha on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of

Rs.2,500/- each, subject to satisfaction of Arresting officer subject to the condition as mentioned u/s 438(2)(i)(ii)(iii)(iv) of Cr P C. Accordingly, they be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the condition as mentioned u/s 438(2)(i)(ii)(iii)(iv) of Cr P C.

At this stage, ld advocate took the accused persons, namely, Sanjoy Singha and Potoka Singha @ Ranjana Singha in his charge and orally undertook that he will keep the accused persons in court room till furnishing and acceptance of bail bonds and if he fails to furnish bail bonds he will hand over the accused persons in judicially custody, and the prayer is allowed. If on bail they will appear before the court on the date fixed.

To date i. e. 13-06-2022 for production of accused Akash Singha and IO's report.

Call for C.D.

Prosecution is directed to ask the information to remain present on that date.
