

State of Haryana Versus Sagar Khattar

Present: Dr. Sumitra, APP for the State.
Accused Sagar Khattar in person, represented by Sh. Kuldeep Sundriyal, Advocate.

Accused Sagar Khattar surrendered before the court and taken into custody. Learned counsel for accused Sagar Khattar has filed an application for bail of accused Sagar Khattar. Power of attorney on behalf of accused Sagar Khattar filed. Notice of the same given to APP for State. Reply to the bail application not filed. However, Ld. APP has opposed the bail application orally. Perusal of case file reveals that accused Sagar Khattar has grossly misused the concession of bail. Notice under Section 446 of Cr.P.C served upon the accused separately and in reply thereto accused pleaded guilty and prayed for lenient view. A penalty of Rs. 2,000/- is imposed upon the accused Sagar Khattar and the same has been paid. Remaining amount of bond is remitted.

Heard on bail of accused Sagar Khattar. Considering the fact that accused has himself surrender before the court a lenient view is taken. Keeping in mind the attending circumstances, and accused Sagar Khattar is re-admitted to the concession of bail on furnishing bail bonds of in the sum of Rs. 75,000/- with one surety in like amount. Requisite bonds furnished, accepted and attested. Papers be tagged with main case file.

Now to come up on **28.10.2026** for prosecution evidence. All remaining unexamined PW's be summoned for the date fixed.
