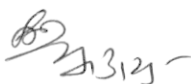

ORDER BELOW BAIL APPLICATION OF ACCUSED
AMJAD KAMRUDDIN KHAN

1. Accused is arrested in above crime on 03.03.2025 and he is taken in MCR. In that, he has made present application for bail on 20.03.2025. Accused sought bail on the ground that, investigation is completed and alleged amount recovered by police. He is innocent and falsely implicated in the said crime. He shall co-operate in the investigation and ready to abide by any conditions, if imposed by the court.
2. Say of IO, Ld. APP and informant was called. They have filed their say and resisted the application.
3. Perused and read application with say of I.O., Ld. APP and informant. Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused and Ld. APP.
4. I.O. and Ld. APP both objected the application on the ground that there is recovery from the accused which shows his involvement in this crime, investigation is in progress, charge-sheet is not filed and therefore his custody is required. They both prayed for rejection. Informant also filed her say and opposed the application on the ground that till date cheating amount is not recovered, as accused is not supporting with the investigating agency. Custody of accused is essential for recovery of property. She prayed for rejection of application.

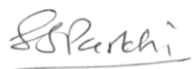
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5. Having considered the facts of the case, nature of allegations and the seriousness of the offence. No recovery is made from the accused. custodial interrogation is not required. The offence is not punishable for Imprisonment for seven years. There is no reason to keep accused behind the bars. Liberty of a person is the constitutional right. Bail is a rule and jail is an exception. Therefore, it is just and proper to release said accused on bail. Hence, following order :-

ORDER

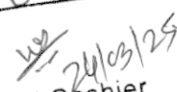
- i) The application is allowed.
- ii) Accused be released on bail on her executing PB & SB of Rs.50,000/- or PB of Rs. 50,000/- and cash bail of Rs.35,000/-.
- iii) Accused shall attend police station on every Wednesday between 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., till filing of final report.
- iv) Accused shall not contact the informant or any other prosecution witnesses in any manner.
