ORDER.

Afore-mentioned applicants/accused **Surinder Pal, Harbans Singh, Janak Rani and Sukhdev Singh** through their counsel have filed the present first blanket bail application for grant of anticipatory bail.

Notice of the bail application was issued to the State.
Learned APP appeared on behalf of State.

ASI Tajinderpal Singh no. 1455/Amritsar posted at Counseling Cell Amritsar City has appeared and suffered a statement that there is one complaint filed by Kuljit Kaur wife of applicant no. 1 Surinderpal Singh which is pending for police inquiry. The applicants have joined the inquiry proceedings. However, the statement of complainant has not been recorded so far and that further proceedings will be undertaken on the completion as well as according to the result of inquiry proceedings.

In view of the same, since only enquiry on the complaint moved by Kuljit Kaur is pending in Police Station/Counseling Cell,

Amritsar City and till date, no formal FIR has been registered against the applicants/accused, the present blanket/anticipatory bail application is rendered infructuous. Accordingly, the present blanket bail application is hereby dismissed being infructuous. However, in view of these facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that the apprehension expressed by the applicants is not totally without any basis. Therefore, it is ordered that in the event of lodging of the FIR disclosing non-bailable offences or in the event of arrest of the applicants by the concerned police authorities, as the case may be, two days prior notice be issued to the applicants, subject to compliance of provision of Section **41(2) Cr.P.C./ 35(2) of BNSS, 2023**. The application stands disposed of accordingly. Bail papers be consigned to the Record Room.
