COMMITMENT ORDER:-

1. The above named accused have been sent up by the SHO, Police Station, Goindwal Sahib in this Court to face trial in the above noted case.
2. Brief facts of the case are that on 21.03.2017 SI Bakshish Singh 1271/TT along with ASI Jassa Singh no.804/TT, ASI Davinder Kumar 964/TT, ASI Surjit Singh no.538/TT, HC Joginder Singh 1404/TT, HC Kuldeep Singh no.273/TT, HC Mehal Singh no.592/TT were going towards the area of Goindwal Sahib from Tarn Taran on patrolling duty and when the police party reached near petrol pump Jamarai where SI Bakshish Singh received a secret information that Satnam Singh son of Tehal Singh, Jaspal Singh son of Ajaib Singh both residents of village Turr, PS Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran who doing a business of Fake Indian currency by making forged currency notes and now they both made Fake Indian currency notes at their house and if raid was conducted, they can be apprehended along with Fake Indian currency notes, machine and other equipments. Information being reliable and offence 489-A, 489-B, 489-C being

committed SI Bakshish Singh after preparing ruqa, the same was sent through HC Joginder Singh no.1404 to the police station for registration of FIR. Firstly investigation was conducted and SI Bakshish Singh along with other police official raided on the place disclosed by secret informer i.e. house of Jaspal Singh. Where the main gate was opened and when the police party entered in the courtyard of the house where the light of the one room was on and the door was locked from the inside and two persons talking with each other in the room. Then SI Bakshish Singh push the door forcibly and the door was opened then SI Bakshish Singh apprehended both the accused person with the help of other police officials and enquired about their whereabouts and one person who printing the notes disclosed his name as Satnam Singh and other person who was cutting the notes with the help of cutter disclosed his name Jaspal Singh. Then SI Bakshish Singh conducted personal search of Satnam Singh as per rules and from the right pocket of his wearing pent 250 notes of 100-100 rupees total Rs.25,000/- were recovered and the number of notes were as 1) 4G7025990 = 36 notes, 2) 5LIC311429 = 25 notes, 3) GAB820346 = 23 notes, 4) 2NU710448 = 58 notes, 5) 2AH81669 = 24 notes, 6) 4BC892141 = 20 notes, 7) AV344443 = 23 notes, 8) SHU507050 = 25 notes, 9) OPC941870 = 16 notes total 250 and then personal search of Jaspal Singh conducted by SI Bakshish Singh as per rules and from the right pocket of his wearing pent 250 notes of 100-100 amounting of Rs.25,000/- of Fake Indian Currency notes were recovered, the number of notes were as 1) GAB820346 = 23 notes, 2) JHU507050 = 23 notes, 3) JGM927782 = 32 notes, 4) 2NU 710448 = 45 notes, 5) 3AV344443 = 6 notes, 6) 2AH816369 = 26 notes, 7) 7DH080861 = 35 notes, 8) PE247630 = 32 notes, 9) 4GT025990 = 28 notes total 250 notes were recovered from Jaspal Singh. SI Bakshish Singh prepared two separate parcels of both recovered notes and affixed their seal BS on both the parcels and taken into police possession vide separate memos. Thereafter he further taken into possession one printer, one lead, one transparent glass, one scale

of glass, one cutter, some blank papers out of which fake currency notes were prepared and the same were taken into police possession by the Investigation officer and affixed his seal BS on the same and thereafter handed over his seal to ASI Jassa Singh. Upon further investigation of accused were challaned and accordingly, arrested in the present case.

3. From the perusal of the report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. and the documents attached thereto, it appears that the accused has committed an offence punishable u/s 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 34 IPC, which is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions.

4. Copies of challan report u/s 173 Cr.P.C has been supplied to the accused free of costs u/s 207 Cr.P.C on 07.06.2021.

5. The Ld. A.P.P. for the State and the Ld. counsel for the accused have been heard and the file of the case has been perused.

6. Keeping in view the above said discussion, the present case is hereby committed to the Court of Ld. Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, for 01.11.2021. The accused, on bail, is directed to appear before the Court of Ld. Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran on 01.11.2021 at 10:00 a.m. sharp. The Ld. A.P.P. for the State has been informed in this regard. Ahlmad of this Court is directed to complete the file in all respects and to send the same to the said Ld. Court well before the date fixed.
