

Balwant Singh Vs. Nihal Singh BA 1629

Present: Sh. K.S.Gill Advocate for applicants/accused

Heard. The accused/applicants have sought his anticipatory bail in complaint case titled as Balwant Rai Versus Rachhpal Singh and others on the ground that they have been summoned for the offence punishable under section 420 IPC on the basis of complaint filed by Balwant Rai. Their custodial interrogation is not required.

Since it is a private complaint, therefore, custodial interrogation of accused/applicants is apparently not required. Thus, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it is hereby ordered to surrender the accused/applicants before the learned trial court within a week and on their surrender, they will be admitted on bail on furnishing their bail bonds in the sum of ₹.50,000/- with one surety each to the satisfaction of trial court and on the conditions as imposed by that learned trial court. In case, the accused/applicants will fail to appear in the lower court within a week from today, the present bail application shall stand dismissed automatically.

Notice be issued to complainant and record from the trial court be requisitioned for 26.08.2021.
