Palwinder Singh Versus State of Punjab

ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose of an application for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of applicant **Palwinder Singh** in CC No.415/25, under Section 160(2) Railway Act, Police Station, RPF Nangal.

2. In pursuance of notice of the application having been issued, the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State has put in appearance and record has been produced by SI Anoop Singh.

3. Learned counsel for applicant has vehemently argued that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in this case. The applicant/accused is an innocent person and has committed no offence. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant/accused. Applicant/accused is ready to join the investigation. Therefore, it is prayed, that applicant/accused may kindly be released on anticipatory bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor for State has hotly opposed the contentions and has argued that the applicant/accused is not entitled to get the concession of anticipatory bail as he while driving the

vehicle bearing registration No.PB-65V-4430 damaged the gate of railway crossing No.46/C between Rupnagar-Mianpur by hitting the said vehicle bearing registration No.PB-65V-4430 with it on 22.08.2025. The custodial interrogation of applicant/accused is required for proper investigation of the case. It is therefore prayed that the anticipatory bail application moved by applicant/accused may kindly be dismissed.

5. SI Anoop Singh RPF, posted at Nangal Dam has appeared and suffered a separate statement that the present case was registered against the unknown Driver of bus no.PB-65-V-4430 u/s 160(2), Railway Act at PS Outpost Rupnagar. No accused has been nominated in the present case till date as record regarding the Driver on the said bus qua the day of incidence yet to be obtained.

6. After giving my thoughtful consideration to the rival submissions and on careful perusal of the averments put in the application, contents of the complaint, perusal of record produced by SI Anoop Singh, coupled with the assistance rendered, it is apt to make mention that on 22.08.2025 a vehicle bearing registration No.PB-65V-4430 came from the side of Nangal-Chandigarh Highway at about 16:35 on 22.08.2025 and hit with the boom of Railway Gate No.46/C between Rupnagar-Mianpur KM No.48/3-4 due to which the gate of the railway crossing was damaged. The driver of the said vehicle fled away from the spot along with his vehicle. FIR was registered against unknown driver of the said vehicle bearing registration No.PB-65V-4430. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has assured that he will fully co-operate the

Investigating Agency and to get recover the vehicle. As such, this Court deems it fit to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the applicant/accused and he is directed to join the investigation within **10 days** from today and in the event of his arrest, he be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount as per the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the applicant/accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court,
 2. He shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence even to the slightest,
 3. He shall render every possible help during the investigation as and when called upon,
 4. He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.
7. He shall make compliance of the provisions enshrined under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. The bail application is accordingly allowed. Copy of order be sent to the concerned Police Station for compliance. Police record has been returned. File be consigned to the record room.
