ORDER :

1. The present bail application has been filed by above named applicants/accused Pargat Singh seeking regular bail, pertaining to above mentioned criminal case.
2. Notice of the bail application was given to respondent/State and learned Addl. PP has appeared for the respondent/State. The record is also produced and perused.
3. Learned counsel for the bail applicant argued that accused remained absent only for short period and then he himself surrendered before the Court. The absence of accused was not intentional rather the reason of absence was beyond his control and unavoidable circumstances and thus he may be granted the benefit of bail again.

4. On the other hand, the learned Addl. PP for the State argued that accused is habitual of jumping the bail and delaying the trial and thus he shall not be granted the bail again.

5. A perusal of the record reveals that in this case the allegations against the applicant pertains to the offence of snatching. The bail applicant was on regular bail in this case but during the trial, he absented from the court proceedings on 03.05.2023 and his non-bailable warrants were issued after cancellation of the bail order on 22.02.2024. Thereafter, he himself surrendered in the court on 15.03.2024 and is in custody since then. This court is of the opinion that the applicant must have learnt a lesson by now for avoiding the process of law. The disposal of the challan is still going to take considerable time. Accordingly, in the interest of justice and in view of the aforesaid circumstances particularly the fact that applicant himself surrendered before the court, the applicant Pargat Singh is readmitted to bail on his furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Requisite bonds not furnished at this stage. This bail application file be attached with the main challan.
