ORDER

This order of mine will dispose of application filed by above named applicants/accused, seeking anticipatory bail in the present FIR.

2. Upon notice, learned Addl. PP for the State appeared and record has been requisitioned.

3. Learned counsel for applicants contended that the applicants have been falsely implicated in this case, due to civil litigation pending between the parties. Only simple injuries are attributed to applicants/accused. Co-accused Kulwinder Kaur had received injury at the hands of complainant and in this regard DDR has been recorded at the instance of Kulwinder Kuar. It is a case of cross version. There is delay of

about 6 days in lodging of FIR. Co-accused have already been granted bail by this court vide order dated 09.06.2025. The applicants are ready to join the investigation. Hence, it is prayed that present bail application may be allowed.

4. Per contra, learned Addl.P.P. for the State along with learned counsel for complainant opposed the bail application. It is argued that the applicants/accused are duly named in the FIR by the complainant and specific role is attributed to them in the occurrence. So there being serious allegations, the applicants are not entitled to anticipatory bail and the bail application may be dismissed.

5. I have heard both the sides and perused the record. The applicants/accused have been booked in this case u/s 115(2), 76, 127(2) BNS on the basis of statement having been made by complainant/victim with the allegations that on 29.05.2025 at about 7.30 AM, she was cleaning outside her house. Meanwhile, accused Iqbal Singh armed with danda, Paramjit Singh armed with danda, Rajwinder Kaur, Kulwinder Kaur and Gurbax Kaur came and they encircled her. Gurbax Kaur exhorted that complainant be not spared and she should be done to death. Upon this, Rajwinder Kaur and Kulwinder Kaur caught hold of her from her chunni around her neck and pressed her neck. Accused Paramjit Singh gave danda blows to her. After removing chunni from her neck somehow she went inside the house. Accused Paramjit Singh and Iqbal Singh also entered in her house. Paramjit Singh caught hold her from chest and torn her jamper from chest with intention to disrobe her. Iqbal Singh dragged her from her hair towards

street. Rajwinder Kaur and Kulwinder Kaur removed her pajama. The motive behind the occurrence is that civil litigation is going on between them. On this statement of complainant, present case has been registered. Copy of DDR No.17 dated 07.06.2025 is placed on file by learned counsel for applicants/accused, as per which this DDR was recorded at the instance of Kulwinder Kaur, accused in the present IFR, against complainant party. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicants and they are ready to join the investigation. So without commenting on the merits of the case, but keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case in hand, this Court deems it a fit case, where applicants/accused can be granted the concession of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application filed by applicants/accused is allowed, subject to their joining investigation within 15 days from today and in that event, they will be admitted on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/SHO concerned, subject to the conditions that applicants/accused will join the investigation as and when required, they will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and will not interfere in the investigation of the case. Non compliance of order will render the bail order vacated automatically. However nothing as observed in this order shall have effect on the merits of the case. Police record be returned. File be consigned to the record room.
