

Jagwant Singh Vs. State of Punjab BA 232-2022

This order of mine shall dispose of bail application filed by accused/applicant Jagwant Singh in F.I.R. no. 186 dated 20.09.2022 under Section 457 and 380 of IPC pertaining to PS Amargarh.

Notice of this bail application was given to learned APP for the State. Investigating Officer is present in the court along with Police record.

Heard. Briefly, the allegations of prosecution are that complainant Rajinderpal Singh has electronics shop namely Chopra Telecom and Electronics shop in village Manvi which is run by complainant. On 06.08.2022 at about 8 AM, complainant went to his shop at Manvi and saw that there was no lock on the shutter of shop and shutter was also little bit open and on checking he found that one fridge, one washing machine, one inverter Battery, one inverter, 2 table fans, 2 ceiling fans, 4 irons, one hand blender, 3 rolls of cable wire, 3 extension boards, 2 water geysers, one gas geyser and Rs.1500/- were missing. The said goods were stolen by some unknown persons in the intervening night of 05/06.08.2022. On the basis of said statement of complainant, F.I.R. in the present case was lodged.

It is noteworthy that recovery has already been effected from the accused. Further the custody of the said accused is no more required for the purposes of investigation and so has been stated by the IO who is present today in court vide his separate statement. Filing of the challan and conclusion of trial will take some time, but no

purpose will be served by keeping the accused in custody till then. In view of the facts and circumstances, accused Jagwant Singh is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. During the period of the bail, the accused/applicant Jagwant Singh will be bound by the following conditions:-

1. He will assist the I.O. in the early completion of the investigation and will make himself present before I.O. or this court as and when required.

2. He will file affidavit regarding his address in the court and he will not change his address without the permission of this court or under intimation to this court.

3. He will not try to influence the witnesses in the present case.

Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished today. Papers be annexed with the main file/remand papers.
