

Bachittar Singh etc. Vs. State

By way of this order I will dispose of present bail application.

It is argued by the Id.counsel for accused that they have been falsely implicated in the present case. Except for the offence U/S 452 IPC, the other offences are bailable. If DDR put by the police is seen, the alleged incident has occurred on a common passage/rasta. As such, accused be released on bail.

On the other hand, it is argued by the Id.APP for State that accused were armed with deadly weapons. Hence, offence being serious in nature, accused be not released on bail.

I have heard the arguments of Id.APP for State and Id.counsel for accused.

If DDR put by the police is seen, the alleged offence stated to have occurred on a passage/rasta as alleged in the DDR. If this so, both the accused shall surrender before the local police within 7 days from today and the local police shall release both the accused on bail on their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.1.00 lac each. Copy of this order be sent to the SHO of P.S. Dasuya for compliance. However, both the accused shall furnish the regular bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1.00 lac each with one surety of the like amount each within one month after the lock down is over. File be consigned to the record room.
